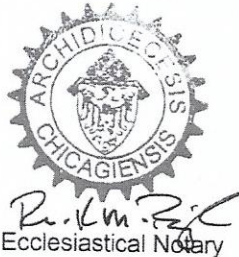

With this letter, in pursuant to Canon 522 of the Code of Canon Law (1983), and the Decree of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops (Nccb-Comp.Nm.5, 1984), I am pleased to appoint you as Pastor of the SS.
